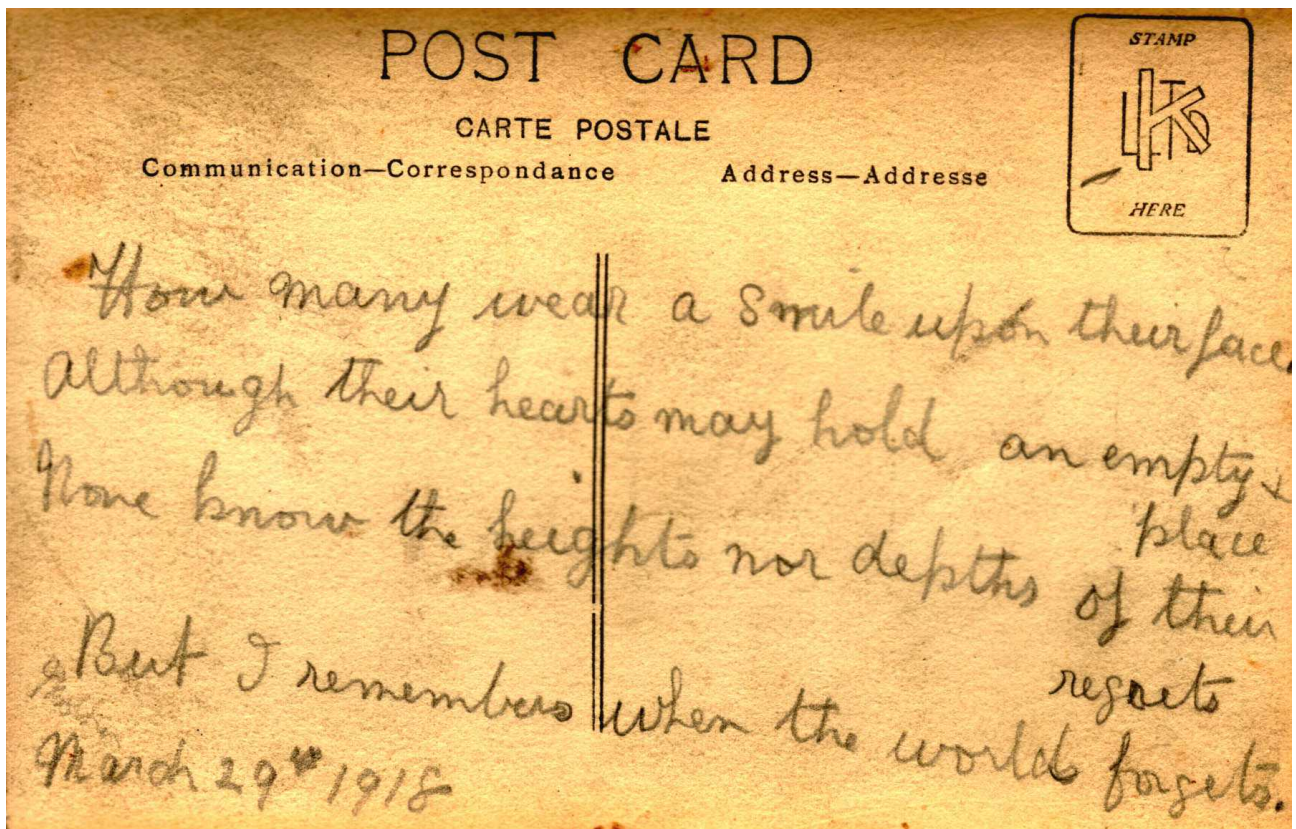




**Private Albert John Mott
203620 - 5th Btn. Royal Berkshire Regiment**

**Died 29th March 1918 Age 37
Remembered with Honour at Etaples Military Cemetery**



On the rear of the photo above, these poignant words were most probably added by Albert's widow, Eliza.

Albert's great-grandson Steve Mott, tells us about the photo...

"...The poem on the back is actually a verse from a 1913 song called 'God remembers when the world forgets', with the last line changed from 'But God remembers when the world forgets' to 'But I remember when the world forgets'

...Albert's widow Eliza came to Bournemouth with my grandparents and lived with them, firstly over the Butcher's shop, and later in Edgehill Rd until her death in 1963. So this postcard was probably put away by her and did not come to light until grandmother died, and the house cleared and sold in 1992 - In fact I only saw this last year, as a small box of photographs turned up in my parents attic, having been put there during the process of clearing grandmother's house, and overlooked...."
